## LAB RELATED INFORMATION

- Please read the lab material before coming to the lab.
- Lab work is to be submitted to the **CS330 LAB: Intro to Operating Systems** UR Courses module
- Labs are due two hours before your next week's lab section (ie. deadlines are: 7:30am for section 95, 7:30am for section 96, and 11:30am for section 97). Be prepared to demo your run in the lab and explain your coding choices if asked. Please note that part of your demo will include a timestamp check to see when your file was last edited. If you make changes to the file after the deadline, make sure that the modification is in a new file.
- Late submissions, without valid reason, will be marked at a penalty of 50%.
- If you cannot attend your regular lab section due to illness, interviews, funerals, etc, let your lab instructor know prior to (or the same day of) the lab. Arrangements will be made so that the 50% penalty does not apply.
- Punctual attendance makes up 1/3 of your lab mark. If you arrive late, you will lose your punctuality mark for that lab.
