

To connect to a computer in Lab with RDP – with a system running MacOS

Preparation

1. Make sure you know the name or IP of the computer in lab to connect to.
2. Make sure you have installed Forticlient VPN software.

3. You will also need to install a Remote Desktop App from the App Store.
4. Note: there is a free version, no need to purchase an RDP app.

Get “Microsoft Remote Desktop 10”, and open it.

RDP Connection

1. Open Forticlient VPN and login with your usual uregina.ca credentials.
2. Open the RDP App you have installed.
3. Enter the computer name or IP of your lab computer when prompted.
4. Enter your username and password when prompted.
5. Click "OK".
6. When finished, close the window (SIGN OUT), close the app, log out of Forticlient VPN.

Note: If you connect to your lab computer, and your usual network drives are not available, you may have to reconnect to OES by going to the System Tray (up arrow near the clock), right-click the big white "N" and click OES Login.
